New Coffee Springs substation on line

WEC is focused on reliability

Reliability is at the top of everyone's list of what they want from their power provider. At WEC, we want our members to know that we are making long-range decisions with the goal of providing the most reliable electric service possible.

In the fall of 2010, we completed construction (in partnership with our power supplier PowerSouth Energy Cooperative) of a new 20-megawatt substation in the Coffee Springs area. The new unit was built on the same site as the older, 10-megawatt unit.

The initial benefit to members is that the new substation will greatly improve the reliability of service in the Coffee Springs area. Along with the addition of the Murphy Mill substation west of Dothan in December of 2009, the Coffee Springs unit helps position your cooperative to handle projected growth in those areas and generally improve distribution service to our members.
