Understanding your WEC billing statement

WEC makes every effort to provide all the information needed to understand your power bill and know exactly where your money is being spent.

1 Distribution Cost

This line item is a clear disclosure of what it actually costs to operate your electric cooperative. It consists of a Facility Charge, which covers some of the fixed costs of delivering power to your home or business and an energy charge to cover the remaining costs of distributing electricity.

2 Wholesale Power Cost

This line item reflects the average base rate per kilowatt-hour that WEC pays its wholesale power provider for the electricity we buy to distribute to homes and businesses throughout our service area.

3 Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment

This line item allows WEC to quickly and accurately respond to monthly and sea-

sonal fluctuations in the cost of generating electricity. Wholesale power is impacted by factors such as weather extremes and movements in wholesale fuel prices. These changes can be reflected on your bill through the Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment.

4 Unpaid balance

This is the amount owed to the cooperative from a previous billing cycle. This amount must be paid **immediately**. This total is past due, and disconnection can occur immediately if this balance is not paid.

5 Total Due Now

This is the amount due the day this bill was generated.

Find ways to save on your electric bill with a free energy audit from WEC

A few simple changes made this winter can lead to a more energy efficient home and savings for your family. The first step in finding out where your home is losing energy is calling Jessie Ingram or Deanna Albritton — trained consultants from the Energy Services Department at WEC.

An energy audit from WEC can identify areas in your home where the cold air of winter is sneaking in, and where your heated air is escaping. “We can help homeowners identify practical steps that can save them a substantial amount of money on their power costs,”

says Ingram, energy services manager for WEC.



Many homeowners are surprised to discover how many air leaks they have around windows, doors, light switches and electrical outlets. Even homes that are considered well insulated often show signs of air infiltration when exposed to an infrared camera.
